ATTENDANCE

Your decision to attend the Summer Session at Notre Dame versus another institution should be made after careful consideration of your academic requirements and costs. **Financial assistance is not available for Summer Session online courses.**

Notre Dame students who elect to attend summer school at another institution are encouraged to consult with an academic advisor to ensure that the course work is transferable to Notre Dame. Although not guaranteed, Notre Dame students may submit a *Summer Cost of Attendance Worksheet* (available at financialaid.nd.edu) to their host institution. The completed *Summer Cost of Attendance Worksheet* must be submitted to the Notre Dame Office of Financial Aid before any loan applications can be certified.

Students who are visiting the University for the Summer Session are not eligible for financial aid through Notre Dame. Visiting students should contact their home institution regarding consortium arrangements.

WHEN TO APPLY

The Summer Session Undergraduate Financial Aid Application is usually available on the Office of Financial Aid website in mid to late February. To receive priority consideration, your Summer Session Financial Aid Application should be submitted to the Office of Financial Aid by April 25.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Students interested in Summer Session financial aid should complete the 2016/17 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the 2016/17 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE. Links to these online applications are available at financialaid.nd.edu.

In addition to the FAFSA and PROFILE, students interested in receiving financial aid consideration for the Summer Session must complete the *2016 Summer Session Undergraduate Financial Aid Application*.

SUMMER SESSION FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES

Federal Direct Loans and private educational loans are available to assist students with their Summer Session financing needs. Information and application procedures are available on our website.
